**REGULATIONS RELATING TO PERFORMANCE OF CERTAIN  
POLICE DUTIES BY MEMBERS OF THE  
NAMIBIA DEFENCE FORCE:  
DEFENCE ACT, 1957**

## SCHEDULE

PERFORMANCE OF POLICE FUNCTIONS IN CERTAIN  
CIRCUMSTANCES BY MEMBERS OF THE  
NAMIBIA DEFENCE FORCE

1. Subject to the concurrence of the Ministers of Defence and Home Affairs and upon the written request of the Inspector-General of Police to the Chief of the Namibia Defence Force, the Chief of the Namibia Defence Force may assign members of the Namibia Defence Force to assist members of the Namibian Police Force in the execution of those functions of the Namibian Police Force which relate to the maintenance of law and order and the prevention of crime under paragraphs (b) and (d) of section 13 of the Police Act, 1990 (Act 19 of 1990), provided that such agreement shall
    - (a) fix the maximum number of members of the Namibia Defence Force which may be assigned;
    - (b) stipulate the period for which members of the Defence Force will be assigned, which shall, except with the prior approval of the Minister of Defence and the Minister of Home Affairs, not exceed a continuous period of 28 days for any such assignment;
    - (c) specify the geographical area or areas in which the assignment shall have effect; and
    - (d) describe the nature of the assignment.
  2. The Chief of the Defence Force, or any officer of that Force designated by him or her for that purpose, shall designate the members of the Defence Force required to perform police duties as contemplated in regulation 1.
  3. Members of the Namibia Defence Force assigned in accordance with these regulations shall perform such duties under the command and control of the officer or officers of the Namibian Police Force under whose authority they were detailed to render service by the Inspector-General of Police or by a member of the Police Force designated by the Inspector-General of Police for that purpose.
