## STATE OF THE NATION ADDRESS: 2015

His Excellency Dr Hage Geingob, President of the Republic of Namibia will deliver his first **State of the Nation's Address at Parliament (National Assembly Chamber) tomorrow Tuesday, 21 April 2015, at 14h30**. This is in accordance with Article 32 (2) of the Namibian Constitution that states that, "In accordance with the responsibility of the executive branch of Government to the legislative branch, the President and the Cabinet shall each year during the consideration of the official budget attend Parliament. During such session the President shall address Parliament on the state of the nation and on the future policies of the Government, shall report on the policies of the previous year and shall be available to respond to questions."
