NOTICES OF MOTIONS

I. Deputy Minister of Finance:

That leave be given to introduce a Bill to amend the Customs and Excise Act, 1998, so as to insert new definitions; to provide for the streamlining of customs controls and customs procedure for the better facilitation of trade and for risk management; to further address ethics and integrity requisites; to strengthen the provisions relating to the exchange of and access to information and confidentiality; to further provide for the territorial application of the Act; to provide for the automation and the use of information technology in electronic commerce; to accommodate the One Stop Border post concept by providing for places of entry or exit in terms of international agreements with SADC member states and adjoining countries; to provide for co-operation between government offices, ministries and agencies to facilitate the functioning of the national single window concept; to change the time frame for the report of arrival and lodging of declarations to the customs and excise office; to permit or require the declaration of goods imported overland to be lodged electronically and prior to importation; to simplify provisions requiring an importer or exporter to produce documents and pay duties; to provide for the registration of legal persons as an authorized economic operators; to provide for the imposition of an environmental levy in respect of certain goods manufactured and imported into Namibia; to require that electronic documents and records be maintained; and to provide for incidental matters,

II. Minister of Labour, Industrial Relations and Employment Creation:

Having been informed that the Cabinet has approved in principle the following persons as members of the Employment Equity Commission for the unexpired portion of the period of office.

- Ms. Charmaine Tjirare (Main Member)- Representing the previously racially disadvantaged;
