# REPUBLIC OF NAMIBIA MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

### **TUESDAY, 8 JUNE 2021**

The Assembly met pursuant to the adjournment.

- 1. The Speaker took the Chair and read the Prayer and Affirmation.
- 2. The Speaker laid upon the Table in terms of Rule 96(a) of the Standing Rules and Orders:

Two Petitions handed to his Office on Friday, 28 May 2021.

The first Petition is by the representatives of the Nama and Ovaherero people, and is rejecting the initiated Reconciliation Agreement negotiated without the participation of the legitimate representatives of the majority of the victim communities.

The second Petition is by Mr. Usutuaije Maamberua, former Member of this National Assembly, and is calling for the full and comprehensive inclusion of the Ovaherero and Nama communities.

The Speaker referred the Petitions to the relevant Parliamentary Standing Committees for investigation and report back to this Assembly.
