Quote "A member may not refer to the names of persons, or any statements of fact, unless they be necessary to render the question intelligible and can be authenticated".

Therefore, I kindly request that Members should endeavour not to refer to names of persons when it is not absolutely necessary and does not add value to the point a Member wants to bring across.

I also remind Members that Ministerial Statements should not be longer than 30 minutes, in terms of Rule 26 of the Standing Rules and Orders of the Assembly.

I further need to state that in terms of Rule 115(f);

Quote "A Member may not in any motion, debate or question, including a supplementary question, refer to matters awaiting or under adjudication in any Court of Justice"
