The policy in its current form provides that, in the event that the wild life destroys people's properties e.g. Mahangu fields, domestic animals and indeed the loss of human life.

The assistance/compensation provided are as follows

- Mahangu field N\$ 800.00 per hector,
- Cattle N\$ 1500.00
- Goat N\$ 200.00
- Sheep N\$ 250.00
- Horse N\$ 500.00
- Donkey N\$ 250.00
- Pigs N\$ 250.00

The most crucial one is the loss of life for human being which the policy provides for the compensation on funeral arrangements only in the region of N\$ 500.00 to be provided to the family

So these compensation really need to reviewed up so they are in line with the current commodity prices and the economic living standard of today

This issue is a national issue that needs to be tackled nationally it should not be left sorely in the hands of the Ministry of Environment and Tourism alone. And

For as long we are proud of the beauty of our ecology which of cores includes wild life that are mostly boosting our tourism industry in attracting significant number of tourist, we are equally obliged to put up harmonious and reasonable assistance to mitigate the negative impact cursed by this beautiful wild life of ours.

No matter how small is the space at our disposal that we are sharing with our wild life species, we must ensure that both human and wild life lived harmoniously with one another in that very available small space, hence I am strongly in



support of the establishment of a special fund to cater specifically for this as a lasting and helpful mitigation efforts
