**Cde Chairperson of the Whole House Committee,  
Honourable Members of the National Assembly,**

1. Thank you for granting me this opportunity to introduce the Budget of the Anti-Corruption Commission for the financial year 2014/15 to this august House.
2. The Anti-Corruption Commission has a separate Vote which is in line with statutory requirements that its operations should be independent. Likewise, its functions are prescribed under the Anti-Corruption Act, 2003 (Act No. 8 of 2003).

The total allocation for the previous financial year was **N\$48,581,000**. For 2014/15 financial year, the Anti Corruption Commission has requested an increase of **N\$6, 211 000** which brings the total amount of the requested to **N\$54 792 000**.

The proposed allocation is to be divided between the three programmes in the Medium Term Plan of Vote 30, namely –

- Investigation of allegations of corruption;
- Corruption prevention;
- Coordination, management and support.

In respect of –

- the first programme an amount of **N\$2 850 000** is being proposed;
- the second programme an amount of **N\$2 800 000** is being proposed;
- the third programme an amount **N\$49 142 000** is being proposed.
- The total allocation proposed is thus **N\$ 54 792 000.**
