REPUBLIC OF NAMIBIA MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

TUESDAY, 28 SEPTEMBER 2021

The Assembly met pursuant to the adjournment.

- 1. The Speaker took the Chair and read the Prayer and Affirmation.
- 2. Mr. Ithete laid upon the Table for discussion:

Report by the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Economics and Public Administration on the Stakeholder Consultation Workshop held at Otjiwarongo from 10 - 14 May 2021.

3. The Deputy Minister of Finance laid upon the Table:

Reports of the Auditor-General on the Accounts of the –

- (i) Ministry of Urban and Rural Development for the financial year ended 31 March 2020;
- (ii) Office of the Judiciary for the financial year ended 31 March 2020;
