REPUBLIC OF NAMIBIA MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

TUESDAY, 9 NOVEMBER 2021

The Assembly met pursuant to the adjournment.

1. The Speaker took the Chair and read the Prayer and Affirmation.

2. **NOTICES OF QUESTIONS:**

- (i) Mr. Murorua (UDF) to ask the Minister of Mines and Energy (No. 84).
- (ii) Mr. Tjeundo (PDM) to ask the Minister of Health and Social Services (No. 85).
- (iii) Mr. Martin (PDM) to ask the Minister of Labour, Industrial Relations and Employment Creation (No. 86).

3. **ORAL QUESTION:**

Mr. Kavekotora (RDP) asked the Minister of Labour, Industrial Relations and Employment Creation (no. 87) *Replied to*.

4. Mr. Kauandenge moved without Notice in terms of Rule 27(h):

That leave of absence due to official business, be granted to Dr. Ester Muinjangue until 22 November 2021.

On the motion of Mr. Vries. seconded by Ms. Hengari, debate adjourned until Wednesday, 10 November 2021.
