REPUBLIC OF NAMIBIA MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

WEDNESDAY, 13 JULY 2022

The Assembly met pursuant to the adjournment.

1. The Deputy Speaker took the Chair and read the Prayer and Affirmation.
2. **Mr. Kauandenge moved without Notice:**

That his Motion to “*Discuss the conditions of Local Authorities and why many of them fail to execute their mandates and whether sufficient resources are availed by Central Government to empower them*”, which I he had Tabled on 2 March 2022 and is on the Order Paper as the Tenth Item; be withdrawn in terms of Rule 30(b) of the Standing Rules and Orders.

Mr. Kauandenge indicated that the Deputy Minister of Urban and Rural Development has consulted him this afternoon and has humbly requested him to withdraw his Motion. He said he is therefore withdrawing his Motion on condition, as informed by the Deputy Minister, that the Ministry has undertaken a comprehensive study following his Motion and that the Ministry will soon Table that Report to Cabinet and then to this Assembly for discussion.

Agreed to.

3. **FIRST ORDER READ:**

Resumption of Debate on youth unemployment crisis in Namibia, its ramifications, both in the short and medium to long term.

Question before the Assembly on Thursday, 7 July 2022, as moved by Ms. Hengari (page 25): That the Motion be referred to a Parliamentary Standing Committee for further scrutiny and report back to this Assembly.

On the motion of the Minister of High Education, Technology and Innovation, seconded by the Deputy Minister of Finance, debate adjourned until Thursday, 14 July 2022.

4. In terms of Rule 99(a) and of the Standing Rules and Orders, the Deputy Speaker adjourned the Assembly at 17:46 until Thursday, 14 July 2022.
