### **NOTICES OF MOTIONS**

## I. Minister of Works and Transport:

That this Assembly -

Agree to the Ratification of two Protocols amending respectively, Articles 50(a) and 56 of the 1994 Chicago Convention on International Civil Aviation, and the 2014 Montreal Protocol to amend the Convention on Offences and Certain Other Acts Committed on Board Aircraft.

# **II.** Minister of Works and Transport:

That this Assembly –

Agree to the Ratification of Accession to the Beijing Convention and Protocol 2010 for the Suppression of Unlawful Acts against the Safety of Civil Aviation.

# III. Dr. Iijambo:

That this Assembly –

*Discuss* and *debate* the relevance of the inherited, yet extremely detrimental post-colonial Roman Dutch Law. The latter derives from the ancient Roman dominion of before 27AD.

Some of the Roman Dutch Law aspects may or could be applicable. Nevertheless, former colonisers excluded traditions, values, rules, norms and culture deserve objective inclusion.

If change is the 'law of nature', our sovereign evolvement must reflect our development.

# IV. Ms. Moongo:

That this House -

*Discuss* and *look* into the deplorable and inhospitable state of our mental health institutions and facilities, whether the conditions provide for an appropriate and therapeutic environment

Further, that this Motion be referred to the relevant Parliamentary Standing Committee for further scrutiny.

#### V. Mr. Muharukua:

Places in Omusati and parts of Oshana Region such as Omahenene, Omakuwa, omangololwani, Epalela, Omindamba, Iishanaputa, Okathakoushongo, Olupaka, Omuulukila, Outapi, Onambelela, Ombafi, Okeeke, Ogongo and Oshitutuma, Oshipanda, Oshikuku, Onampila, Emo, are some of the villages that have access to the water flowing through the Omahenene Canal.

That this House therefore –

*Debate* the provision of 40% subsidies towards communal crop farmers residing in these villages and all other villages along the water canal; and

That this Motion be referred to the relevant Parliamentary Standing Committee for further investigation.
