### **NOTICES OF MOTIONS**

#### I. Minister of Finance:

That leave be given to amend the Appropriation Act, 2022 so as to increase and decrease certain amounts of money in the Schedule to that Act to meet the financial requirements of the State during the remainder of the year ending 31 March 2023.

## II. Minister of Industrialisation and Trade:

That this Assembly –

*Agree* to the Georgetown Agreement as amended by the  $110^{th}$  Session of the ACP Council of Ministers held in Nairobi, Kenya on  $7^{th}$  December 2019, and endorsed by the  $9^{th}$  Summit of the ACP Heads of State and Government in Nairobi, Kenya during 9-10 December 2019.

## III. Mr. Muharukua:

That this House -

*Debate* affirmative action measures specifically targeted at, and tailored to alleviating the socio-economic challenges faced by the previously disadvantaged members of our Defence Force and our Police Service while they are in service and after they retire.

Further, that this Motion be referred to the relevant Parliamentary Standing Committee for further scrutiny.

# IV. Mr. Kauandenge:

That this Assembly –

*Discuss* the establishment of a genocide Memorial Museum for the 1904 genocide perpetuated against the Ovaherero and Nama Community.
