#### NOTICES OF MOTIONS

#### I. Prime Minister:

That this Assembly –

In accordance with Article 112(3) of the Namibian Constitution:

*Approves* the appointment by His Excellency the President of Mr. Saalman Dhameer Jacobs as the Chairperson of the Public Service Commission.

#### II. Deputy Minister of Home Affairs, Immigration, Safety and Security:

That leave be given to provide for compilation and maintenance of a Civil Register; to provide for appointment of Registrar-General and Registrars; to provide for appointment of an Age Determination Committee; to regulate registration of births, stillbirths, adoptions, deaths, marriages and divorces; to provide for name changes and other alterations to the Civil Register; to provide for the issue of identity documents to certain persons listed in the Civil Register; to provide for an Appeals Tribunal and incidental matters.
