1. Rights of Public Entity

The national Assembly reserves the right:

2. Preparation of Quotations

Late quotations will be rejected.

11. Evaluation of Quotations

The Public Entity shall have the right to request for clarifications in writing during evaluation. Offers that are substantially responsive shall be compared on the basis of evaluated cost to determine the lowest evaluated quotation.

12. Scope of Services, Specifications and Performance Standards

Bidders may propose alternative for part of the scope substantiating that such alternatives will equally serve the interest of the Public Entity.
