## **BILL**

To amend the Extradition Act, 1996 so as to delete the ground of refusal of extradition where a person is convicted in his or her absence by a court in a requesting country.

(Introduced by the Minister of Justice)

**BE IT ENACTED** by Parliament, and assented to by the President, of the Republic of Namibia, as follows:

#### Amendment of section 5 of Act No. 11 of 1996

1. Section 5 of the Extradition Act, 1996 is amended by the deletion of paragraph (a) of subsection (2).

#### **Short title**

2. This Act is called the "Extradition Amendment Act, 2023".
