# REPUBLIC OF NAMIBIA MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS OF THE

# NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

## **WEDNESDAY, 15 NOVEMBER 2023**

The Assembly met pursuant to the adjournment.

1. The Speaker took the Chair and read the Prayer and Affirmation.

### 2. Hon. Katoma laid upon the Table for discussion:

Report of the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Foreign Affairs, Defence and Security on the Benchmark Visit to its Portfolio Counterpart Committee of the Parliament of Zimbabwe from 6-10 February 2023.

#### 3. **NOTICES OF QUESTIONS:**

#### 4. Ministerial Statement in terms of Rule 98 of the Standing Rules and Orders:

The Minister of Industrialisation and Trade informed the nation that the Government through its agency, the Business and Intellectual Property Authority (BIPA) on 31 October 2023 announced the launch of the Annual Duty Penalty

Waiver Programme, effective from 15 November 2023 until 31 March 2024. The waiver period covers the years 2012 up to 2022.

The Minister urged entrepreneurs in all 14 regions to make use of this relief accorded to them in order to avoid last minute applications.
