EIGHTH SESSION, SEVENTH PARLIAMENT

REPUBLIC OF NAMIBIA MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

WEDNESDAY, 29 NOVEMBER 2023

The Assembly met pursuant to the adjournment.

1. The Speaker took the Chair and read the Prayer and Affirmation.

2. Announcement by the Speaker in terms of Rule 20(b) of the Standing Rules and Orders:

The Speaker reported that he has been informed by the Secretary of the National Assembly that the Committee on Standing Rules and Orders and Internal Arrangements approved the membership of Honourable Phillipus Katamelo and Honourable Helaria Mukapuli, as Members of the Select Committee on Budget.

The Speaker declared these Members as duly appointed to the said Parliamentary Select Committee.

3. URGENT ORAL QUESTION:

Hon. Dienda (PDM) asked the Minister of Defence and Veterans Affairs (No. 57) – *Replied to*.

4. **FIRST ORDER READ:**

Resumption of Debate on the establishment of specialized schools for the Kavango East and West region.

Question put: That the Motion be referred to a relevant Parliamentary Standing Committee for further scrutiny and report back to this Assembly.

The Speaker ruled that the Report be withdrawn by Hon. Mukapuli, Vice Chairperson of the Public Accounts Committee, for proper input by the Committee and report back to the Assembly.

Agreed to.

7. FOURTH ORDER READ:

Consideration of Report on the 27th Session of the Conference of the Parties (COP 27) held in Sharm El Sheikh, Egypt.

Hon. Dr. Iijambo moved on behalf of Hon. Tweya, seconded by the Hon. Deputy Minister of Fisheries and Marine Resources: That the Report be now considered.

Agreed to.

Question put: That the Report be adopted.

Agreed to.

8. **FIFTH ORDER READ:**

Consideration of Report on the Oversight Visit to Aqua-Culture Projects of the Ministry of Fisheries and Marine Resources in Kavango East, Kavango West, Omusati, Oshana, Omaheke and //Kharas Regions.

Hon. Mukapuli moved on behalf of Hon. Tweya, seconded by Hon. Kooper: That the Report be now considered.

Agreed to.

Question put: That the Report be adopted.

Agreed to.
