**MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS**  
**OF THE**  
**NATIONAL ASSEMBLY**

**WEDNESDAY, 8 NOVEMBER 2023**

The Assembly met pursuant to the adjournment.

1. The Speaker took the Chair and read the Prayer and Affirmation.
2. **Announcements by the Speaker in terms of Rule 20(a) of the Standing Rules of and Orders:**

- (i) The Speaker announced that he has been informed by the Chief Whip of the SWAPO Party, that the Party has nominated Hon. Kletus Karondo to serve on the Standing Committee on Foreign Affairs, Defence and Security.
- (ii) That he has also been informed by the Chief Whip of LPM that the Party has nominated Hon. Edson Isaaks to serve on the Standing Committee of Natural Resources, and Hon. Henny Seibeb to serve on the Standing Committee on Foreign Affairs, Defence and Security.
