REPUBLIC OF NAMIBIA MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS OF THE

NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

THURSDAY, 25 APRIL 2024

The Assembly met pursuant to the adjournment.

- 1. The Deputy Speaker took the Chair and read the Prayer and Affirmation.

The main event will start at 18:00 and the entrance fees are as follows:

- A table for 10 people is N\$20 000.00 for VVIP; and
- For individuals the tickets are N\$500.00 for VIP and N\$50.00 for the general public respectively.

In total, there would be 9 (Nine) fights scheduled for the evening.
