LAUNCH OF VEHICLE REGISTRATION FOR LEGISLATURE

1. On Tuesday, 30 April 2024, the National Assembly and National Council, the two Houses of the Parliament of Namibia, will jointly launch their Vehicle Registrations.
2. The vehicles belonging to the Parliament will be easily identifiable by a green vehicle registration plate displaying the abbreviation "LNA" for Legislature National Assembly and "LNC" for Legislature National Council.
3. This initiative, similar to other State Organs, is a commendable gesture that not only distinguishes the Legislature's vehicles but also underscores the significance of the Separation of Powers among the three Organs of the State.
4. As the Legislative Branch of the State, Parliament has the exclusive responsibility of overseeing the Executive's activities. With the introduction of these distinctive number plates, the public will now be able to readily identify vehicles belonging to the Parliament. Only official vehicles of the two Houses of Parliament will bear these unique number plates. This is one of the ongoing reforms undertaken by Parliament in its endeavor to establish an independent Parliamentary Service Commission.
