# NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

# **WEDNESDAY, 5 MARCH 2025**

The Assembly met pursuant to the adjournment.

1. The Deputy Speaker took the Chair and read the Prayer and Affirmation.

# 2. **NOTICES OF QUESTIONS:**

4. Ministerial Statement in terms of Rule 136 of the Standing Rules and Orders:

The Minister of Environment, Forestry and Tourism inform the Assembly on the adjustment of the off-set payment for cattle loss under the "Human Wildlife Conflict Self Reliance Scheme".

The Minister announced that the off-set payment for cattle loss has now been adjusted from five thousand Namibia dollars (N\$5 000) to eight thousand Namibia dollars (N\$8 000). This adjustment will be implemented from 1 April 2025, while all other payments will remain the same as adjusted in September 2024.

Agreed to.
