REPUBLIC OF NAMIBIA MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

WEDNESDAY, 2 SEPTEMBER 2026

The Assembly met pursuant to the adjournment.

1. The Speaker took the Chair and read the Prayer and Affirmation.
2. **Rulings by the Speaker in terms of Rules 6 of the Standing Rules and Orders:**

- (i) During the sitting of Tuesday, 1 September 2026, a Member took the floor to present a petition. Rule 216 requires every petition to be lodged with the Secretary of the National Assembly, while Rule 217 governs its presentation to the House. The Speaker deferred the Ruling on the matter.

On Wednesday, 2 September 2026, the Speaker, therefore ruled that the petition may not be presented at this stage. It may be lodged with the Secretary in accordance with Rule 216 of the Standing Rules and Orders. This ruling does not deny the constitutional right to petition the Parliament; it regulates the procedure for exercising that right as per the Standing Rules, Orders and Internal Arrangement.

- (ii) Secondly, the Speaker ruled that Members must strictly adhere to the dressing code of the National Assembly as stipulated in terms of Rule 73 (e) and Sub Rule 4 of the Standing Rules and Orders and that no clothes associated with party colours or emblems or insignia must be worn.
